Dear Residents of LivGenerations Ahwatukee and Family Members,

Home Isolation:

Based on the outcomes of our testing last week, we implemented home isolation requirements. This can bring up a lot of questions regarding what home isolation exactly means and how we move beyond the home isolation period. Home isolation is defined as all residents staying within their apartment home until the requirement is lifted. Home isolation dramatically reduces the opportunity for any additional cases. Three meals a day will be delivered to your apartment home. Vibrant Living activities are available virtually in your apartment home. Communal amenities outside of your apartment home are closed and all family visits are suspended.

If you still need to utilize medical care from outside entities or when you interact with team members during meal delivery, you must wear a mask. Consistent hand washing and surface sanitizing is still recommended.

When Is Home Isolation Lifted?

Our Liv Well Task Force and management team is counting down the days with you. Thank you for complying with this 14-day isolation period. This requirement of home isolation will be lifted on Saturday, July 11th.

Our Liv Well Task Force is committed to complete transparency through this process. We will continue to notify you on the number of cases in our community. Know that we are working to contain any further spread and will conduct all necessary contact tracing and testing to fence in the virus.

This time of home isolation can also be very mentally and emotionally taxing. We encourage residents and family members to stay actively engaged through

technology. Please take advantage of the “Send Some Luv” digital greeting cards, virtual vibrant living programming and facetime calls to stay connected and involved. For those with a balcony, take in fresh air daily.
