Dear Residents of LivGenerations Communities,

Continuing our week of good news, this memo is to offer some additional details around off campus mobility for our independent and assisted living residents. While we are all excited to reach this point in our pandemic journey, we plead with all who take advantage of this offering to be disciplined with their safety measures, including; washing and sanitizing hands, limiting high contact touch points, practicing social distancing of 6 feet or more, avoiding large gatherings and wearing a mask at all times when away from the community.

Beginning September 9, independent and assisted living residents can leave the community for appointments and other personal matters. Residents may use their own vehicles or have a family member provide transportation.

The off campus mobility safety protocol steps are:

- Check out at the front desk with the Concierge between the hours of 8 a.m. and 7 p.m.
 - Residents and family member(s) are required to read, sign and agree to a Screening and Pledge form and sign out on the Resident Log.
 - Departures must occur during concierge working hours.
- Off campus mobility is not subject to a time limit, but please use best judgment per notes above.
- Overnight excursions are not allowed without a 10-day home isolation upon return.
- Residents who leave the community are agreeing to randomized COVID testing.
- Testing will be available onsite or a resident can choose to have tests at a provider of their choice.
- Testing cadence will be dependent on the number of times a resident leaves.
- Testing costs will be the responsibility of the resident. We have secured reasonably priced tests for your convenience.

Per yesterday's memo based on the Governor's Task Force recommendations, we are now offering in-community, in apartment home family visits with proof of a negative COVID test. Proof is defined as a copy of the actual test results for the community files, presented in person at the time of the visit. A doctor's note will not be recognized. Socially distanced, outdoor visits are also still available at the communities without COVID testing.

Thank you for the support and dedication to the communities' well-being to date. The safest place to be during this pandemic is within the community, but we understand that we must begin to live with this new reality. If the community experiences any outbreaks, we will be required to return to past policies for safety. This is a team effort, and in order to continue our steps of re-opening we must all work in unison to protect our individual and collective health.
