Dear Residents of The Springs of Scottsdale and Families,

The latest influx of positive COVID-19 cases in the greater Phoenix area reminds us how virulent this invisible enemy is and just how important it is to stay within the safe confines of your apartment home. We beg of you to consider this information as you weigh your thoughts regarding being with family during the Thanksgiving holiday.

Per the AZ DHS, we are recommending that all residents stay at the community and do not join family offsite for the Thanksgiving holiday meal. Thanksgiving Day will be special within our community and the culinary team is preparing to serve a traditional Thanksgiving meal.

We understand how difficult it is to be apart on holidays as many of us will also be spending the day without loved ones. We can only do our best in encouraging you to put safety above tradition, but for those of you who absolutely cannot accept the reality of the risk associated with going home for the holidays, we will require a 10-day quarantine upon return with the option to test out of quarantine at the 7-day mark. Testing will be provided by Liv Communities and administered onsite by a Liv clinician.

Today, November 20, we have no (0) residents and one (1) team member diagnosed with active case of COVID-19.
