Dear Residents of LivGenerations Pinnacle Peak and Family Members,

We cannot thank you enough for your courage, patience and vigilance against this virus. We know the current active cases within our community is discouraging, but we ask you to keep strong so we can be better positioned for visitations and celebrations around the holidays.

We are working to do our part with weekly testing for both residents and team members. Our team members are receiving constant reminders and re-training on COVID protocols. The safety measures we've put in place to minimize interaction between residents and team members and among residents are starting to pay dividends.

We are in communication with the Arizona Department of Health Services regarding the timing of vaccinations and as soon as we hear anything, we will pass the news along. In the next few days, we will send a short survey to benchmark the level of interest in receiving an inoculation. Please respond so we can properly forecast and prepare a smooth pathway for a successful dissemination of the vaccine. A safe and effective vaccine will be available soon and our community is on the frontline for access. Please stay hopeful.

Today, December 9, we have one (1) resident and seven (7) team members diagnosed with active cases of COVID-19. All positive team members are on sick leave and not within the community. The resident with an active case is quarantined in their apartment home.
